

**Gunner Noel Thurston Tuthill**  
**Regimental number: 308112**  
**125<sup>th</sup> Heavy Battery, Royal Garrison Artillery**

**born: about 1896 - died: 14 September 1918**

Gunner Noel Thurston Tuthill was born probably in early 1896.<sup>1</sup> He was baptised on 4 February 1896 at Holy Trinity Church in Toxteth Park, near Liverpool, Lancashire, the son of Charles and Rosanna Tuthill.<sup>2</sup> His father, Charles William was born in about 1865<sup>3</sup> and his mother, Rosanna (née Thurston) in about 1870.<sup>4</sup> Both his parents were born near Mutford in Suffolk and were married there in 1887.<sup>5</sup> They had at least fourteen children – eleven of who had survived to 1911.<sup>6</sup> Those who were identified – thirteen children, two of whom died before 1911 – were: Charles William (born in about 1888),<sup>7</sup> Rossana (born in about 1889),<sup>8</sup> Henry James (born in about 1891),<sup>9</sup> George Thurston (born in about 1892),<sup>10</sup> Lillian (born in about 1894),<sup>11</sup> Noel, Harriet Ann (born in about 1897 and died in about 1902),<sup>12</sup> Marie May (born in about 1899),<sup>13</sup> Isaac Thurston (born in about 1900 and died the following year),<sup>14</sup> David Thurston (born in about 1903),<sup>15</sup> Violet Grace (born in about 1904),<sup>16</sup> Ivan Oswald (born in about 1908)<sup>17</sup> and Priscilla A. Jane (born in about 1910).<sup>18</sup>

Their first two children – Charles and Rosanna – were born when they were still in Suffolk. But in about 1891, the family moved to the Liverpool area and were living at 45 Cleopas Street in Toxteth Park, where Charles was a general labourer. The next six children were born in the Liverpool area. By 1901, the family had moved to Catherine Terrace in Litherland, where Charles was now a dock labourer. Sometime between 1901 and 1903, the family moved back to Suffolk and, in 1911, they were living at 46 Kirkley Run in Lowestoft and Charles was, once again, a general labourer.

Noel enlisted in the Royal Garrison Artillery in Liverpool. He served in the 125<sup>th</sup> Heavy Battery, which went to France in April 1916. The Heavy Batteries were most often used to destroy and neutralise enemy artillery. On 13 September 1918, Noel was admitted to the 1<sup>st</sup> Canadian Casualty Clearing Station with a compounded fracture to his left leg, which was amputated, and gunshot wounds to his right leg and right hand.<sup>19</sup> He died on 14 September and was buried that day in Duisans British Military Cemetery (Grave 67, Plot 5, Row H), with the chaplain W. Fisher presiding.

Duisans British Military Cemetery is located in Etrun, near Arras, in France. The first burials took place in the cemetery in March 1917.<sup>20</sup> The 1<sup>st</sup> CCCS arrived at the beginning of September and was stationed near Duisans for two months in the autumn of 1918.<sup>21</sup> A total of 75 patients died at the 1<sup>st</sup> CCCS in September 1918.

His next-of-kin was his father, who was living at 347 Grafton Street in Toxteth, and he was notified of his death.<sup>22</sup> His mother received the monies owing to him from the army after his death.<sup>23</sup>

Noel was awarded the British War Medal (for service overseas between 1914 and 1918) and the Victory Medal (for service in an operational theatre).<sup>24</sup>

Several of Noel's brother also served in the Great War. His eldest brother, Charles, who was an engine driver, enlisted as a Private in the Suffolk Regiment (Regimental number 13988) on 2 September 1914.<sup>25</sup> He also served in the Royal Engineers and the Military Foot Police Corps.<sup>26</sup> He was appointed Acting Lance Corporal in October, but reverted to Private in February 1915. He joined the British Expeditionary Force in France on 26 July 1915, just a week after he married Ellen Maud Tuttle on 21 July in Lowestoft, Suffolk.<sup>27</sup> In 19 June 1919, he was demobilised and transferred

to the army reserve.<sup>28</sup> Like his brother, he was awarded the British War and Victory Medals).<sup>29</sup> Since he served before the end of 1915, he was also awarded the 1914-15 Star (for service in the war against Germany between 5 August 1914 and 31 December 1915).

Although Noel and Charles were army men, their four brothers went to sea. Three brothers served in the Royal Navy Reserve Service – Henry,<sup>30</sup> George<sup>31</sup> and David.<sup>32</sup> George was also a British Navy seaman in 1919.<sup>33</sup> David and Ivan were both ship crew, serving as bridge boys – David in 1924 by the age of 21 on the ss Cedric<sup>34</sup> and Ivan by the age of 14 on the R. M. S. Baltic.<sup>35</sup>

One of Noel's sisters left England for the United States. Violet Grace, a domestic, first went to Canada in 1923, going to London, Ontario – possibly for a visit.<sup>36</sup> In September 1927 she sailed again from Liverpool and went to Canada as a landed immigrant, going to St Thomas, Ontario.<sup>37</sup> In 1930, she went to Detroit, Michigan in the United States.<sup>38</sup> She was a servant in the home of David and Sylvia Spiechler.<sup>39</sup>
